









## NORTH AREA INTER-CLUB JUNIOR CHALLENGE 2013

The five North Area clubs (BASOC, Moravian, Grampian, Invoc and MAROC) are having our annual inter-club junior challenge **at the MAROC Level C event** at Creag Choinnich, **Braemar on 1**<sup>st</sup> **September**. This is a great area for orienteering in Upper Deeside. Parking and registration will be located of the A93 on approaching the village from the Ballater direction.

The junior competition format means that **all juniors can participate**, right down to the **very young** who do White courses. In fact the competition is biased towards those who you are still finding your way in the sport.

The challenge will be decided by taking the **best 10 finish positions** for each club's juniors from the white to light green courses (after we've removed all adult runners and any non-North juniors from the results). Boys and girls are scored separately. Please note that this competition is aimed at juniors who are still working up to run at Green standard or beyond. Any junior can enter, but in the spirit of the competition we would ask everyone to run the colour of course that you'd normally enter. Please don't enter an easier course than you normally would just to get a higher position. Junior Co-ordinators from clubs will be asked to keep an eye on this and will advise their juniors appropriately.

There's no limit to how many represent their club, but just the best 10 count. All competitors must be full members of their club and members of the Scottish Orienteering Association.

Although Juniors can enter on the day, we really would like everyone to enter in advance by sending an email to <a href="EEE@marocscotland.org.uk">EEE@marocscotland.org.uk</a> with your name, BOF number and course by 4pm on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> August. This will help make sure we have enough maps available. To help filter the emails, please put EEE - NORTH AREA INTER-CLUB JUNIOR CHALLENGE in the subject line for the email. For those who send in an early email entry, you just come to registration at the event, pay for your run and pick up a timing brikke. (There is no need to complete an entry slip.) Full event details will appear on the MAROC website.

There will be a trophy presentation to the winning club at about 1.45 (or earlier if eligible runners have downloaded) and medals will be presented to their 10 counting runners.
