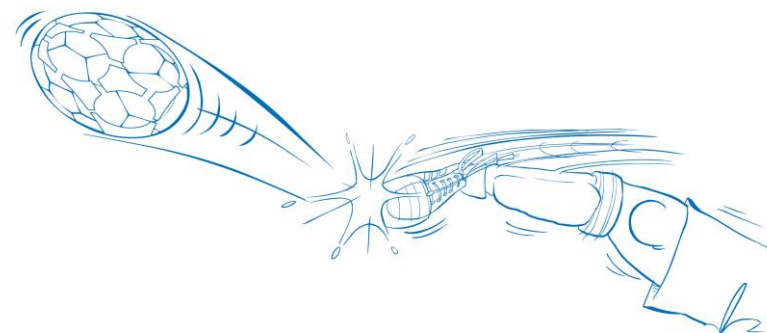

Football P1-7

Athletics P1-7

Athletics will be led by Level 3 Coach, Ruth Watson, with Hannah Smart and Ross Anderson assisting. These sessions will focus on aspects of sportshall athletics and introduce basic run, jump, throw activities. This is open for P1-7 and we will group the children accordingly. Meet at the Aboyne Community Centre reception.

Cost: £5 per session.

Canoeing P5-S3

Aboyne Canoe Club have opened up their Thursday night training in the holidays for P5-S3 pupils to come along and try canoeing/kayaking in the pool. This is a great way to try the sport before going along to an open water session and if you are considering our summer camp this is a good chance to learn the basics. Meet at Aboyne Community Centre reception at 6.20pm.

Cost: £5 per hour

Orienteering P5-S3

Orienteering is a great way to get out running in the woods and take part in problem solving challenges. These sessions introduce children to map reading, problem solving and physical exercise in the outdoors. The sessions will run at Deeside Activity Centre (near Aboyne), Haughton Park (Alford) and Cambus O'May forest (near Ballater) with Sarah Dunn, Scottish Orienteering development Officer. Children need to dress for the outdoors with warm layers and waterproof clothing, plus trainers for running.

Cost: £5 per session.
